Time

One class period

Procedure

Provides your students with a variety of questions (see sample questions below) that make them combine their keyboarding and imagination skills. Then, have your students type out each question and type an answer using complete sentences.

Some sample questions are:



- What do you think Martians do for fun on Mars?
- What two people would you most like to have a picture taken with?
- What color best defines the mood you are in right now?
- If you owned a restaurant, what type of food would you serve?
- Who would you least likely expect a phone call from?
- If you created a new flavor of ice cream, what would it be?
- What three words come to your mind when you hear the word purple?
- What do you consider the worst household chore?
- If you had to watch one movie a million times, what would it be?
- If you could have anything in the world, what would it be?
